Hey Kids!

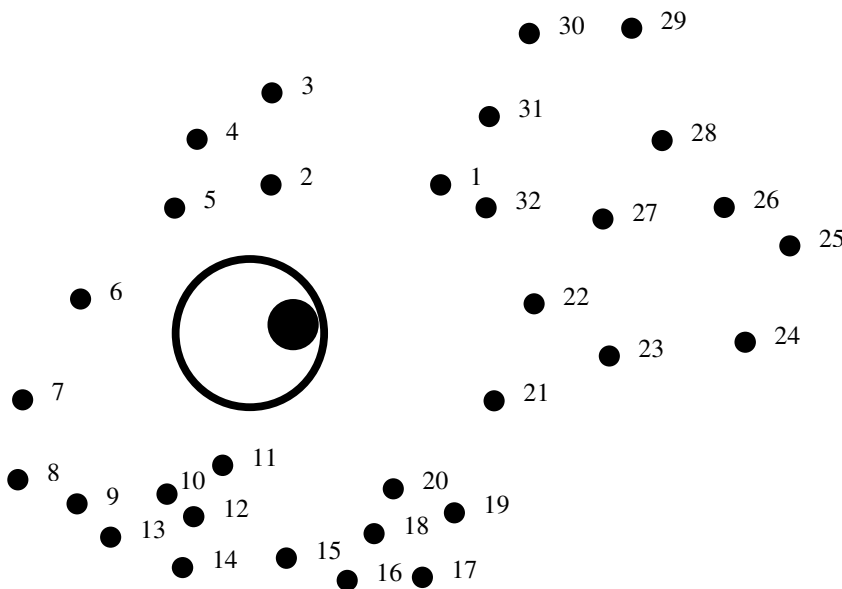
Good day to all readers of the Banana!

Join the Dots

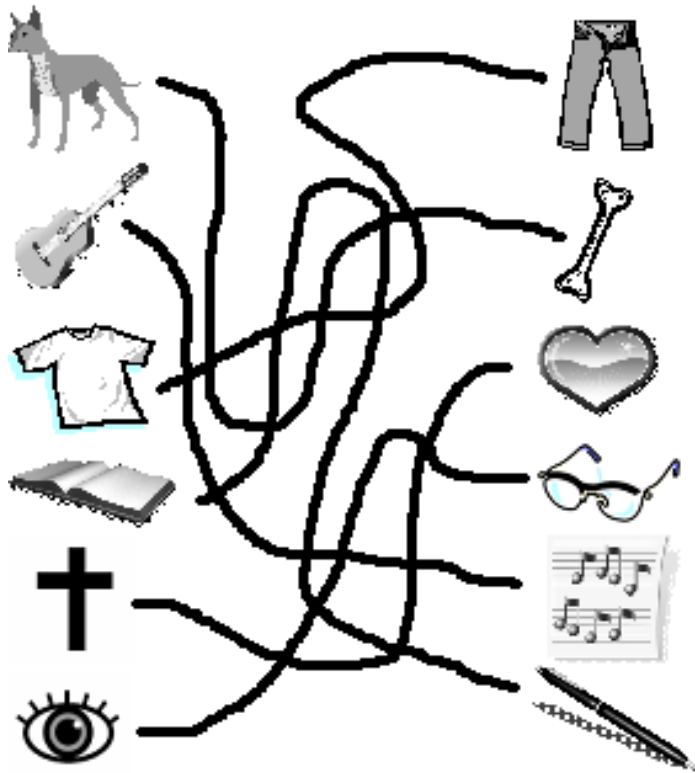
Can you join the dots to reveal this picture? What is it?
